CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

It is once again time to report to our members on Club North Haven's progress for the past year. I am pleased to be able to advise that it has been a successful year for your Club, and I expect that the coming year will be better than the last.

Our trading areas have all done extremely well, and our financial position is strong. Our reported profit for the year is quite large, as it reflects the sale of the Motel leasehold. With adjustment for this, our actual trading profit is slightly down on last year, but is still considered satisfactory. Once again, Seagulls Restaurant has performed amazingly, and credit must go to Warren and his team. They continue to push out high-quality meals at a reasonable cost. We have a very strong balance sheet, and our cash flow is still strong, one of the main indicators of a Club's performance.



Our renovations are proceeding on schedule, and our members can notice the changes taking place, almost daily. Normally, there can be a slight disruption to trade whilst the work is being carried out, but there doesn't seem to have been any significant reduction to date. Once complete, Club North Haven will be a showpiece and our members can look forward to the best facilities in the area.

The atmosphere in the Club continues to be happy, and our free Thursday entertainment is still attracting patrons. The build-up of the Club Super draw has no doubt been a big drawcard having exceeded \$50,000. Other entertainment has been well received, and we have some great shows coming up, so keep an eye out for the shows happening over the next few months.

Once again, I thank my fellow Directors for their support and hard work during the year. Unfortunately, one of our Directors had to resign due to circumstances that would have prevented him devoting the time needed. I thank Terry King for his efforts. In terms of the Club's Constitution we appointed Darren Mearrick to take his place. He is enthusiastic, keen to promote the Club, and work in with the Board. Three Directors positions need to be filled this year and myself and Carole Graham will be standing for reelection. There is one other position available, being the position held by Ken Johnston, who sadly passed away after illness.

The staff have once again proven that they are the best in the business. Our teamwork and co-operation are second to none, and I couldn't single anyone out for praise, as I value them all. Thank you. Our management team of Peter and Shane continue to put in the hard yards, and keep the ship sailing in the right direction.

The reason any Club is successful is the support of its members. The Club is here for the benefit of the members, and our success enables us to provide a friendly and comfortable facility for you. Thank you for your continued support.

TREASURER'S REPORT

First glance at the accounts and we see a profit of \$559,258 for the year which is something that hasn't been seen before but I will try to give an explanation.

We leased the motel and showed a net gain of \$550,158 from that so net profit drops back to \$9,100 and then add back depreciation (\$540,636) and we have an operating gain of \$549,736.

The motel was leased so as to give us an assured income for the year while not being up for operating costs etc. but we do retain ownership of the land and buildings capital gains on these will still belong to the club.

Bar sales were down slightly for the year but industry reports that is the trend Australia wide. Warren and the staff in the restaurant gave a great contribution with a profit of \$17k while maintaining the excellent standard of the meals.


